**Registration Info**: Register your team using tabroom.com. The deadline is noon on Wednesday, March 19. Schools are obligated to fulfill judging commitments and cover entry fees which become binding at noon on Thursday, March 20.

**Legislation**: Upload your bills to Tabroom by Monday, March 17 at 12pm. All bills must be uploaded as a Word file (not a Google doc or pdf). Legislation packets will be published as soon as possible.
