To eliminate unfair advantage, only posted legislation may be used in chambers. Legislation should be submitted to tabroom in PDF format using the template on the site.

Participants

- 1. Remain in the same chamber for both sessions.
- 2. Select a PO for each session.
- 3. Will determine Top PO with one vote per school.
- 4. Collect your score sheets from Tabroom.
- 5. Set agenda one student per school.
- 6. To help shyer speakers, precedence will not reset for session # 2.

Scorekeepers

1. Will write critiques for speeches. Please provide detailed comments.

2. Will rank all speakers at the end of each session (based on speeches, questions and general decorum. The PO can be included in your ranks.)

Parliamentarians

- 1. Will score the PO twice during the session.
- 2. Will rank all speakers (after session 2) based on both sessions.
- 3. Will conduct voting for session PO's and Top PO.
- Register on www.tabroom.com \$ 10 per student. One judge for 1- 5 students.

Two judges needed for 6 or more participants.

Individual Events Info

Entries: There is no entry limit in each event, however, the top 25 contestants from each school will be determined for team trophies.

Rules: This tournament will follow WFCA rules. If your school participates in WISDAA tournaments/festivals, please advise your students of the differences in rules where applicable. **Registration Info**: Registration will open on tabroom.com The registration deadline is 5:00pm on Wednesday, February 5.

Judges: Each school must supply one qualified judge for every five entries or fraction thereof. (For example, if you have ten entries, you must provide two judges. If you have eleven entries, you must provide three judges.) A limited number of hired judges will be available at \$150 each. All judges must have linked accounts on tabroom.com in order to be registered and judge. Directions are posted on the tournament website. Specific directions will be emailed to judges when rounds are released. All judging will be completed online.

Fees: Individual Events \$15; Group Events \$20; Congress \$10 (Congress details are included on above). Fees will be calculated based on your entries as of 5:00pm on Thursday, February 6. COVID Protocols: Wearing a mask in our school building is optional. Students who choose to wear a mask during their performance will not be penalized by judges, or subject to critique for wearing a mask.

Security: Our school district updated its security plans. Included are rules for us regarding entry to the building. When you arrive, you must enter via the main entrance at WEST High School. These will be the only doors that are unlocked. These doors shall remain unlocked from 7:00 AM - 8:30 AM.
